KIDS 6 - 8 years old	Poule system	Competition duration is 1 minute
KIDS 8 - 9 years old	Poule system	Competition duration is 1 minute
KIDS 10 - 11 years old	Poule system	Competition duration is 1 minute
CADETS 12 - 13 years old	Poule system	Competition duration is 1,5 minutes
CADETS 14 - 15 years old	Poule system	Competition duration is 1,5 minutes
JUNIORS 16 - 17 years old	Poule system	Competition duration is 2 minutes

Mandatory protection:

Chest, head, hand, groin and shin guards

The chest and head protector are provided by the organization

Hand and shin guards: only the white type is allowed (no bag gloves)

Mouth guards are optional and not mandatory.

General Rules :

The general Shin / Kyokushin contest rules will be applied to our tournament. To protect our youth, the following techniques are prohibited and strictly monitored by our referees.

Prohibited techniques

For all categories: Kids, cadets & Juniors

- * Straight kicks to the face : Mae - yoko - ushiro - kakato - en hiza geri
- * Rolling kicks
- * Ushiro mawashi
- * Mawashi geri to the head: only Skin Touch
- * Knock - out / knockdown techniques
- * Fist punches beside the chest protection on the arms with the intention to do damage
- * Kick techniques to the knees.

Scoring Criteria :

Kids & cadets :

A controlled kick to the head (Skin Touch) can be rewarded with a waza-ari.

Other criteria are timing, speed, spirit, technical skill and kime.

2x waza-ari = ippon

Winning the game = 3 points

Draw = 1 point

To lose = 0 points

Juniors :

A controlled kick to the head (Skin Touch) can be rewarded with a waza-ari.

Solid punches or kicks to legs or torso that ensure that the opponent does not fight any further (no knockdown).

A combination of a succession of effective techniques such that the opponent is overpowered can also be rewarded with a waza-ari.

2 x waza-ari = ippon

Winning the game = 3 points

Draw = 1 point

To lose = 0 points

DISQUALIFICATION

disqualification of the entire tournament.

There will be strict supervision on the use of unauthorized techniques and this will be sanctioned.

The frequent repetition / application of unauthorized techniques may lead to disqualification of the entire tournament.

Failure to timely register at the tatami for the game will lead to disqualification for this game. (1 minute)
